Invitation for Motor Summit 2012, 5-6 December 2012 in Zurich, Switzerland

We are pleased to invite you to the Motor Summit 2012, which brings together selected international and Swiss national experts and industry representatives to exchange information on the latest developments concerning motor systems worldwide, from an energy efficient point of view.

Topics discussed on the International Day (Wednesday, 5 December 2012) include the status of the Ecodesign process and of the Electric Motor Systems Annex (EMSA) of the International Energy Agency's Implementing Agreement for Efficient Electrical End-Use Equipment (4E), as well as motor standards in the USA, China, and the new standards of the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) for motor efficiency classes and testing.

Major topics of the Swiss Implementation Day (Thursday, 6 December 2012) are the Swiss policy for efficient electric energy use, minimum energy performance standards, future technologies, motor testing, and good examples from motor efficiency projects in industry with efficient pumps and fans. Also first results of the financial incentive program Easy will be provided.
