### CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

(updated on 23 March 2020)

#### BACKGROUND

The Motor Summit ([www.motorsummit.ch](http://www.motorsummit.ch)) is the international conference focusing on policies, standards and technological developments for energy efficient electric motor driven systems.

Since 2007, nine Motor Summits were held in Switzerland. This year, the Motor Summit 2020 International will take place on 18-19 November 2020 in Zurich, Switzerland. The Motor Summit is organised in alternating years to the international Energy Efficiency in Motor Driven Systems (EEMODS, see [www.eemods21.org](http://www.eemods21.org)) conference.

From 2020, the Motor Summit will be put on an open stage for qualified international speakers: for the first time a call for abstracts is published now. The goal is to allow for a greater variety of global input by speakers to the event which will be even more attractive for the audience from industry, academia, government and research.

#### Requirements for abstracts

Submitted abstracts should include:

1. Title
2. Main author and co-authors including affiliation, country and contact data
3. Indication of topic (numbers 1 to 6.2) and technology area (letters a to g); e.g. 2.1.c. MEPS for pumps
4. Length: max. 2000 characters (including spaces and title)
5. Additionally, max. 5 keywords.

Authors may submit more than one abstract.

### EVALUATION

Criteria for the evaluation and selection of abstracts for presentation by the Motor Summit 2020 Steering Committee:

- Pertinence to topic and technology area
- Novelty, new insights or new technology (not published before), no overlap with other abstracts
- Contribution to the advancement of energy efficiency in electric motor driven systems
- Quality of content both in terms of scientific evidence as well as structure and language
- Fit with overall conference programme
- Wide and balanced geographic/regional distribution within overall conference programme.

### NEXT STEPS

Authors whose abstracts are accepted will be required to:

1. Register for the conference.
2. Send a photo and a short biography according to the template provided.
3. Send a two-page summary of their presentation for the conference proceedings according to the template provided.
4. Send their presentation in advance.

**Please note:** All speakers are required to register for the Motor Summit after their abstracts were accepted and pay the reduced registration fee for speakers (CHF 500).


